The Tiger One Bank employees/students presented a slide show which showed the various services they

offer to students at Breckinridge County High School.

The students at BCHS are offered the opportunity to open savings accounts with a minimum of \$5 that earn 1% interest annually. Students are allowed to make three withdrawals per month. They can get money out during their lunch on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.

BCHS students can cash a check at Tiger One Bank, whether it is from mom or a paycheck from work. If they have an account with Tiger One check cashing is free. If not there is a 50 cent check cashing fee.

Tiger One Bank offers two different kinds of loans. Lunch loans can be received for up to five dollars for school lunch. A first time regular loan can be received from five dollars up to fifty dollars. Students are given two weeks to pay back their loans. Interest and late fees also apply to these loans.

This Year Tiger One has given out 30 loans, totaling nearly \$625 opened 40 new accounts given away prizes during opening week and are raffling off two watches.
