GEORGE MARSHALL speaks at Chamber July Breakfast.



George Marshall, LCSW, Therapist with Breckinridge Health Tranquility Program spoke to the Chamber members and guest at the monthly breakfast July 21 at Little Dave's Restaurant & Pizza.

George told those in attendance that the Tranquility Clinic is designed to help Senior Citizens cope with many of the difficulties they face as life changes. Those who qualify are individuals 65 yrs old and older who are struggling with some or all of the symptoms listed: decreased ability to cope with change, inability to adjust to retirement, loss & grief, depressed mood, difficulty coping with health/physical changes, difficulty concentrating, sleep or appetite changes, anger, worry, anxiety, nervousness, isolation, loneliness or social withdrawal as well as feelings of hopelessness or helplessness.

The program is confidential and provides group, individual, and family therapy as well as medication management for behavioral health. The program coordinates the patient's care with the individual's primary care physician.

A meal is provided during the treatment day. The program last for 6-12 weeks with follow-up care provided after discharge.

The treatment team is multi-disciplinary in design to ensure quality patient care. The team includes the patient, family members, family doctor, medical director, nurse manager, clerk, program director and primary therapist. Spotlight day for Holt House

During the time of the Civil War most Americans knew the name Joseph Holt, but now it is almost forgotten. Judge Holt served as Judge Advocate General under President Abraham Lincoln and following his assassination presided over the trial of the Lincoln conspirators.

Today, Judge Holt's history is being reclaimed. On August 15, from 9 AM to 5 PM, CDT, Judge Holt's house in rural Breckinridge County will be spotlighted as a site along the Kentucky Lincoln Heritage Trail. Once named one of the most endangered historic places in Kentucky, the Holt House has become a Legacy Project of the Kentucky Lincoln Bicentennial Commission. Now owned by the county, efforts are underway to preserve this important historic structure in partnership with the Kentucky Heritage Council/State Historic Preservation Office and Kentucky Historical Society.

The celebration will feature a variety of events including an Honor Guard from the Judge Advocate General's office at Fort Knox placing a wreath by Judge Holt's grave at 11 AM. Music from the era will be performed, free refreshments provided, and the home will be open for tours. A customized Kentucky Lincoln Heritage Trail passport stamp will be given; for more visit www.lincolntrail.com

The release of *Judge Joseph Holt*, telling the story of one of Kentucky's highest-ranking national figures and his remarkable life, will be available for purchase and signed by author Susan B. Dyer. The home is located on US 60 four miles east of Cloverport; exit US60 onto KY 144 north, travel six miles.
